In 2013-14 we have been allocated £8,365	<p>£2000- Purchase of new outdoor resources which will support physical development within Early Years. Early years staff will run a fitness club using resources.</p> <p>£365- Purchase of new resources for key stage one and two yards which encourage physical development. PE coordinator to provide coaching to lunch time staff.</p> <p>£6000 - £2000 per term on specialist sports coaching in gymnastics and multi skills.</p>	<p>Children will develop an understanding of and a love of exercise form an early age. Physically they will develop skills and agilities early.</p> <p>Children will spend an hour a day of recreational time with access to sports equipment. We are already seeing a number of clubs run by the children themselves.</p> <p>Staff will observe and team teach with coaches developing their ability to teach high quality PE.</p>	<p>Club will be run by staff members. School budget will renew resources when required.</p> <p>Enterprise event at Christmas will see profit used and banked to allow for replenishment of resources. The current bid for free outdoor Gym equipment will provide another vehicle for encouraging sports participation. Training support staff will give them skills for life in encouraging active participation through organisation of activities and small games.</p> <p>Staff will develop their own skill and confidence in delivering sports in the future. School would continue to try and fund sorts coaches through our own reserves in the future but the coaching will support those PE lessons taught by school staff.</p>
